DESCRIPTION

The modeling and talent competition has run for 89 years at the Westfield Fair Grounds during the annual Westfield Fair. It has provided girls of all ages with confidence, pride and an amazing and rewarding experience. It is a chance to make new friends, express yourself and shine bright. Come and experience the talent our Community has within our young women!

The competition is broken into four categories, Formal, Sportswear, Talent and Photo, which each category is described below. You can enter one or all category.

CATEGORIES

FORMAL: Sunday Best is appropriate. Short dresses or tea length for the 12 & Under age division. Age appropriate gowns or fancy dresses for the 13 and over age division.

SPORTSWEAR: Off the rack clothing. Anything age appropriate goes (*back to school wear, tennis wear or short outfits, etc.*).

TALENT: Solo performance including vocal, dance, twirling, instrumental, acting, poetry, etc. Performance should be no longer than 3 minutes. A piano is not available. Please have all music on CD or iPod cued and ready to go.

Ages 4 & up.

PHOTO: 5x7 or 8x10 black and white or color photo. Must be sent in no later than August 15, 2016 to be judged. No late photos accepted. Photos will be judged then displayed at the Fair.

AGE DIVISIONS

JUNIOR DIVISION: 0-3 years old; 4-6 years old; 7-9 years old; 10-12 years old

SENIOR DIVISION: 13-15 years old; 16-18 years old; 19-21 years old; 22 years and above
